SUBJECT: Minutes for Seoul Computer Club Feb 14, 2004

The Seoul Computer Club met at the USO at Camp Kim, Saturday Feb 14, 2004. The monthly topic was Microsoft Front Page. The guest speakers were Jim Roysdon, Functional Technology Specialist for Yongsan Garrison Child and Youth Services Program; and Freddie Means, a teenager from Camp Humphreys.

Host, Vice President, White, opened the meeting with the introduction of new attendees while attendees enjoyed pizza and sodas. There were 3 new attendees. 46 people attended the meeting including children from the Future Leaders Club. Two new lifetime members signed up and received a Club Coin.

The meeting started off with the Beginner's Corner this month. Special Projects Officer, John Balfour, did the presentation. He did a hands-on demonstration of Norton 7.0 Ghost. This third party application allows an operator to "take an image" of a hard drive and load another hard drive or many hard drives to look exactly like the first one. He asked for volunteers to do perform the simple steps. In all, 6 hard drives were "ghosted".

Jim Roysdon, did the main presentation on Microsoft Front Page. He was ably assisted by Freddie Means on the computer. Mr. Roysdon demonstrated how to quickly and easily create a web site with this application. He covered using tables, frames, GIF's, JPEG's, alternate text and much more. He showed how it could be created and edited with straight HTML or drag-and drop methods. He fielded several questions from the attendees.

The Computer News was next on the agenda. President Gleason was at his best with this month's interesting news tidbits from the computer world.

Old club business covered the club gift of \$500 to the Pear Blossom cottages and a postponement of the annual golf tournament start time. The golf course is under renovation and only part will be available by May. It will be rescheduled at a later time.

New business covered the possible gift of the club's old server to the USO which has been gracious enough to house our meetings for years.
