Host, Heidi Haugen, our treasurer, opened while we all enjoyed pizza and soda. B.J. presented his regular interesting news feature which included discussion of problems with Windows XP Service Pack 2. It breaks many applications.

Marc Miller, our speaker for The Beginners Corner, gave a presentation on buying a used car over the Internet. He discussed the reasons one would buy a car in this way, showed us where to find cars advertised, and took us through the steps to assure that a car has been appropriately inspected and is what you would really want to buy. Then he went through the ways of closing the deal, paying for it.

Our main topic, Voice Over IP, was presented by John Milburn. John went over what you need in order to set up a system whereby good quality long distance phone calls can be made as local calls. John used a Vonage Box but showed us links to other options as well. He discussed various price options available at vonage.com and demonstrated use of the box. We actually made a phone call to the States with excellent results. John and others who have this system commented that step by step instructions come with the box, making it easy to set up, including overcoming the firewall. He told us that call forwarding, voice mail, call waiting, all come with the system. John provided us with numerous links so that we can make full use of this technology.
