SUBJECT: Minutes for Seoul Computer Club July 10, 2004

The Seoul Computer Club met at the USO at Camp Kim, Saturday July 10, 2004. The monthly topic was Securing the e-Vote. Our guest speaker, Steve Janss, columnist for Network World, discussed how e-voting in the ideal situation should be carried out. Steve discussed encryption, authentication and verification.

Host John Phillips, public communications officer, opened the meeting, introducing Jason Lee, CEO of Petramedia, and colleagues who began a demonstration of a Pioneer external DVD writer. During initial setup, Jason gave a brief presentation of the history of DVD recording. During the meeting an entire movie was downloaded, and we viewed a bit of it at the end of the meeting. The process was reported normally to take fifteen minutes with 4x DVD and to be faster with 8x. Sales Representative for Petramedia, Mr. Song Yong Eul, spoke to us about the company's recorders and DVDs. SCC members are at present offered a 10% discount on recorders and on DVDs as well.

Mark White, vice president, handed over the proceeds from our golf tournament, a check totaling \$5, 730.00 to our treasurer, Heidi Haugen.
